City of Lufkin Burn Policy:

- (1) No person shall leave a fire unattended. There shall be at all times a device or substance available to extinguish the fire and no person shall allow the fire to become so large that it cannot be controlled by the means available to extinguish the blaze;
- (2) Tires, bulky items, petroleum products/byproducts or hazardous material shall not be burned. This list is not all-inclusive. All materials must be "natural".
- (3) Burning shall be limited to 1 hour after sunrise and be complete 1 hour before sunset.
- (4) Fires shall be controlled so as to not create dense smoke or a nuisance situation for residents of the City.
- (5) No fire shall be placed or allowed to spread within fifty (50) feet of any property line, structure or vehicle.
- (6) The City of Lufkin Fire Marshal or designee may cancel a controlled burn if in his/her determination weather conditions are not favorable to open burning and such burning would create an unreasonable fire hazard.
- (7) The wind should not be over 23 mph at anytime. The wind should be in a direction as to not obscure visibility on the roadways.
- (8) If a complaint cannot be remedied, you will be responsible for hauling off waste in a timely manner.
