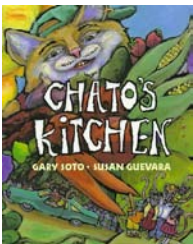


Programming at the Library

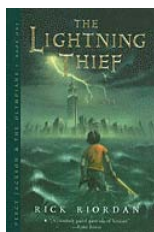
Our first program will be Bilingual Family Pajama Story hour and will be held on September 13th, and every second Monday of the month afterwards.
