We're so excited about this year's Downtown Hoedown! **Saturday, April 17** will start with the Downtown Hoedown Parade. After the parade, folks will enjoy more live entertainment in historic Cotton Square Park, shopping for arts & crafts, and sampling a wide variety of food. Other activities such as a fashion show, petting zoo, train rides, and live entertainment will make this event a big hit. This event, sponsored by all local media, is advertised extensively! We're planning on a great day and are working to make this year's Hoedown **BIGGER** and **BETTER**! Come and join us!

RULES:

1. Vendor applications w/booth fee must be returned by April 2, 2010. **No checks** will be accepted as payment after March 31, 2010. Vendors provide tables, extension cords, etc.
2. Set up must be completed and all vehicles removed by 8 a.m. Saturday. Free all day parking is available outside the blocked-off area.
3. Please enter and exit Lufkin Avenue carefully from event area - First and Second Streets will be congested due to the Hoedown parade.
4. No vulgar or profane merchandise allowed. No pop toys are allowed. No illegal knives are allowed per city ordinance. **The organizer has the right to refuse the sale of any merchandise they deem inappropriate.** This is a family event!
5. Handicrafts, antiques, collectibles, food, home-baked goods and gifts are encouraged. Garage sale items are not allowed.
6. Electricity (110 & 220) available first-come, first-served for \$20 and \$25 respectively. Plugs are limited to three. Water hook-ups are not available.
7. Booths are on downtown streets & sidewalks: spaces are approx. 12' x 14'.
8. Craft spaces are \$50; food spaces are \$60. Electrical service is extra (See prices above)
9. Tents and awnings are allowed but must be suited to a concrete surface.
10. Vendors must remain until 5 p.m. when show is over.
11. Bags of ice will be available for sale. (Small Bag-\$ 2.00, Large Bag-\$7.00)

Please Note: Fees are NON-REFUNDABLE regardless of circumstances.

Duplications are allowed with regard to crafts and collectibles; we try to keep duplicate food items to a minimum.
